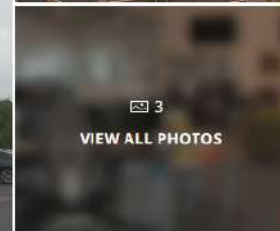


# Local real estate company 'lynding a hand' to health officials during COVID-19 pandemic

SAN ANTONIO - The **Lynd company** is doing their part to help those on the front lines.

Through its extensive program called "Lynding a hand," the real estate company says they are donating \$5 of each rent payment from their residents to Methodist Hospital and the Hope Cares program.

The money is for preventative equipment to help them fight COVID-19, the total amount will be between \$60,000 and \$80,000 .

"We wanted to set an example for businesses to give back during this time to crisis and do our part to try to beat this thing," A. David Lynd, CEO with Lynd said.

Lynd also said they will most likely continue to donate money on behalf of their renters each month until the pandemic is over.



LYND has created a program called "Lynding a Hand" whereby it will donate FIVE dollars from every rent payment it receives to local hospitals in each of the metropolitan areas in which it operates.

With 20,000 units under management in 17 cities, the company estimates it can raise tens of thousands of dollars for the cause. "If we are going to get through this crisis, we are going to have to do it together with everyone doing their part to help," said A. David Lynd, LYND CEO... See More
